Membership Policy

- To help us plan and promote activities, everyone using the Youth Space needs to have taken out membership.
- Every time you attend the centre, you will need to show your ID card as proof of membership.
- Please help to make the centre an enjoyable place by showing all centre users and staff equal levels of respect.
- For the safety and well-being of everyone, members must observe all of the centre rules.
- If you are asked to leave three times for breaking any of the Youth Space rules, your membership may be suspended for a minimum of one week.

Security Policy

- For security purposes, you will need to walk through a security arch. You may also be searched by a member of staff with a hand-held 'wand'.
- Members who refuse to follow the entry procedure, or fail to pass through the search arch without triggering an alarm, will not be allowed into the Youth Space and may have their membership suspended.
- Bags should be left in the lockers available and should only be brought into the centre in exceptional circumstances. All bags brought into the centre will have to be searched first.
- The centre is a substance-free environment – please do not bring drugs and alcohol or any prohibited items.

Safety Policy

- Please do not smoke or roll up in or around the centre, including the garden area.
- For your own safety, please avoid play-fighting, fighting, or running around the centre.
- Appropriate clothing must be worn at all times. Hoods, hats and balaclavas are not allowed.

Note

- Please co-operate if you are asked to leave the centre. If your membership has been suspended, please do not attend until the suspension is lifted.
- Refusal to leave, or attempted entry whilst on suspension, may lead to the police being called.
- The police may be notified and may search and/or arrest you if you have been seen with drugs or weapons.
